EACH TEAM PLAYING ON REISCH FIELD NEED TO PROVIDE A PARENT FOR CONCESSION ONE HOUR PRIOR TO GAME TIME.

FALL BALL RULES

1. A game is made up of six (6) innings. An official game if shortened due to darkness or rain, called at the discretion of the umpire, is four (4) innings, (three and a half innings if the home team is winning). If the game is called and is a complete game but ends in a tied, you revert back to the last full inning where there wasn't a tie and the team ahead will be declared the winner.
2. Pitchers are allowed no more than two (2) innings in a game and 3 innings in a week, 12 year olds can not pitch. Batting team coach will pitch to the younger players as needed. One pitch in an inning constitutes an inning pitched unless the coach pitches the majority of that inning.
3. Players will not sit two consecutive innings. When younger players are at bat bring the younger players onto the infield and move the older players to the outfield except catcher, no stealing when these younger players are on the infield.
4. Players will bat in a continuous lineup. All the players are in the lineup.
5. **Must Slide Rule:** If a play is being made at any base and the ball beats the runner, then the runner must slide or attempt to get around the fielder. Fielder can not block the bases, but can block home plate if the ball has beaten the runner. If the runner does not slide then the runner is out. Play must be close, this rule is not to manufacture outs.
6. Substitutions: **Any** of the players may be withdrawn and re-entered into the game, especially the less ability player, try to rotate the poorer ability players each inning (league rule). No stealing home.
7. **Base Running:** When the pitcher is in contact with the "circle of Dirt" and in possession of the ball and the base runner shall not leave their bases until the ball has crossed the plate.
8. The maximum number of runs per inning, for the first five innings, is 5 runs. Any innings thereafter shall be unlimited runs.
9. No stealing of any bases. Unless there are 2 outs in the inning.
10. Other rules will be taken from the Babe Ruth Baseball Rules hand books.
11. Pitching - There are no walks - Pitcher throws until there are one of the following: 4 balls, a strikeout, or ball is in play. Offensive coach will stand behind pitcher and calls strikes. Offensive coach will pitch to batter in the event of 4 balls. Coach will pitch 2 balls, unless all the pitches from player were balls player will receive 3 pitches, or the last pitch from coach was fouled off.
