# Tournament Team Application

All games will be held at the Scott Kinzinger Complex  
at 525 Grove Street, Honesdale, PA

Opening games at 6:00 pm on July 15th

**Rules & Regulations:**

- This is NOT an All Star Tournament. 12U Teams to be composed of any 12U players from your league. 10U Teams to be composed of any 8-10 year old players from your league. 10 year olds may double roster if needed, but must do 10U skills.
- Proof of age required. Copy of original 2016 Spring Roster child played on or copy of Birth Certificate due at Tournament Credentials meeting. Rosters must have 12 players. Must play with 9 players on the field and a minimum of 10 player in the lineup otherwise an out will be assessed for the spots under 10.
- We will be batting in a continuous line up and players must get 2 innings in the field in each 6 inning game.
- Pitchers may pitch max of 3 innings in 1 game and no more than 4 innings between 2 games.
- No outside food or drink for anyone, except a cooler with drinks in the dugout for players & coaches.
- Tournament will be Round Robin format with a 3 game minimum, top 2 teams advance to Championship game, next 2 teams advance to consolation game.
- Awards for the top three tournament teams and team skills competition champs.
- Registration Fee of \$250 plus \$100 security deposit per team. \$25.00 per team discount if entering both tournaments.
- Payment due June 16th.
- No Pets, Tobacco or Alcohol allowed on HLBA property.
- Teams must bring 6 Tournament Grade Baseballs to the Tournament meeting on July 15th @ 4:30 p.m.
- Coin toss to determine home team (third base dugout) - Championship round better record is home team.
- Max of 3 coaches in the dugout, plus scorekeeper.
- 10 run mercy rule is in effect after 4th inning. No 3rd strike drop ball rule. No excessive delayed base running.
- There will be a 90 minute game limit. Home team gets to bat if inning was started prior to 90 minute mark. Umpire & Tournament Director will monitor time. No time limit on Championship game.
- Cal Ripken rules shall be used for all other rules not listed.
- Team must provide Additional Insured Certificate with both Honesdale Little Baseball Association and Honesdale Borough listed as additional insured (both addresses on bottom of "Team Roster" form).
- Coin toss 1 hour before game. Home team gets field half hour before game, Visitors 20 minutes before game time.
- Additional information on following pages. No refunds. Managers are responsible for the conduct of their spectators.

## **CREDENTIAL MEETING**

We will start taking credentials at 4:30 pm at Scott Kinzinger Sports Complex. You will be meeting at the porch of the snack bar. Please park in the parking areas. There will be a brief meeting at 4:45 pm so please have all coaches attend. All teams must have a coach present or there will be fine assessed to your league.

## **SKILLS COMPETITION**

Skills Competition will take place on Saturday, after your first game that day. All teams must be present for the Skills Competition or there will be fine assessed to your team for not participating and the manager benched for the next game. All players must be in uniform. Every player must participate in at least one event and no more than 2 events.

## **ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR TEAMS AND SPECTATORS**

1. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD IS TO BE BROUGHT TO THE FACILITY!** If you do so, your team will lose their deposit and your food & beverages will be confiscated. Please patronize the snack bar.
2. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES!** You will be escorted off the property and the Police will be summoned.
3. No animals are allowed.
4. **No tobacco or smoking paraphernalia** at the Complex, including parking areas.
5. Park at your own risk, Honesdale Little Baseball Association (HLBA) or the Borough of Honesdale are not responsible for any damage to personal property or injuries to persons attending this tournament. No parking along Grove Street. No parking along driveway. No parking in any neighbor's driveways. Police will ticket any parking violators.
6. **NO NOISE MAKERS** such as horns, cow bells, etc.
7. Help us keep our park clean and use the multiple trash cans around the park.
8. Please do not hang over the fences around the field. There are plenty of bleachers and areas that you can put chairs up. If you bring a canopy or umbrella, you must keep it behind any spectator.
9. We have bathrooms. Please encourage your young men to use these.
10. Absolutely no un-sportsmanlike conduct will be tolerated, violators will be removed from facilities.
11. No solicitation of any kind other than the host.
12. Any team that does not complete the entire tournament including skills competition, will lose their deposit.
13. No spectators between dugout to dugout area.
14. Any rain could backup or eliminate any of the tournament activities, there are no refunds.
15. All players must be rostered in your league and played in half of their regular season team's games.

Note: There will be a minimum of a 45 minute and no more than an hour between games, unless your's or opponent's first game goes longer than expected or your's or opponent's first game is finished unexpectedly early. (Directors discretion) Be prepared for minimal delays.

Any team that does not complete the entire tournament including skills competition will lose their deposit.
